2024 and Beyond Goals:



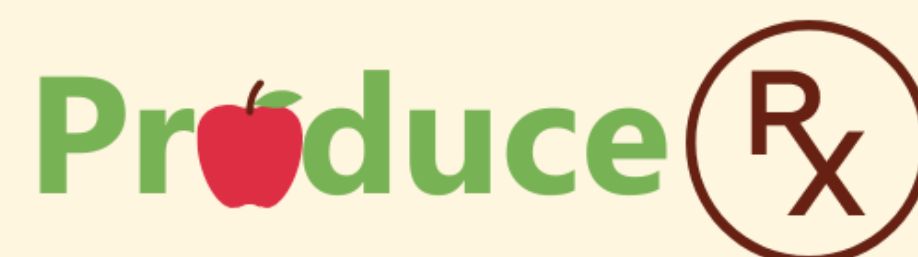
Build an infrastructure to support a statewide Double Up program.

Current related work

Statewide IDOH Pilot with 13 local grantees implementing Produce Rx projects. The program ends 5/30/2024 and will be evaluated at the end! Report will include impact assessment and structural best practices for local implementation in Indiana.

2024 and Beyond Goals:



Indiana University will lead a Community of Practice that will provide peer-to-peer learning opportunities for local Food is Medicine Implementers.



Focus on advocacy around Medicaid waivers and flexibilities to expand Produce Rx programming.



Apply for GusNIP grant (and/or addition funding sources) to support statewide Produce Rx programming.
